COVID-19 OFFICE CLOSURE

On 30 September 2021, President Cyril Ramaphosa addressed the nation, confirming that South Africa had emerged from its third wave of COVID-19 infections, and consequently moved the country to Lockdown Alert Level 1.

The Council for the Built Environment (CBE) will continue to temporarily close its offices to external visitors in an effort to minimise any potential risk of infection and exercise its responsibility in mitigating the spread of COVID-19. The following status continues to apply during this closure:

1. Majority of the CBE staff complement will continue to work remotely until otherwise communicated.
